## **REVISED** **GRAVEL PROCESSING PROPOSAL**

TO: THE BOARD OF COUNTY ROAD COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF ST. JOSEPH,  
STATE OF MICHIGAN

1. This is the proposal for Gravel Crushing at Cranberry Lake Pit Located at 11546 Cranberry Road Marcellus, MI 49067. In Section 29 of Flowerfield Township.
2. This proposal, presented in a sealed envelope conspicuously marked, "SEALED BID. Gravel Processing AGGREGATES", shall be publicly opened and read aloud in the office of the Board of County Road Commissioners of the County of St. Joseph, Centreville, Michigan, at 10:00 A.M., EST, June 20, 2024. The products as shown in the Schedule of Prices shall be produced at the Cranberry Lake Road Pit, located on Cranberry Road, ½ mile West of Bent Road, in Section 29, Flowerfield Township.
3. It is understood and agreed, that should this proposal be designated as the successful bid, a certified or cashier's check for Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars shall be submitted to the Board of County Road Commissioners. Said check shall be held by said Board in lieu of "surety" in the same amount until the successful bidder finishes operations covered by this agreement.
4. The specifications governing materials and subsequent performance, after this proposal is sealed, in accordance with the *Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction*, as adopted by the Michigan State Highway Department and dated 2020.
5. The materials shall be surfacing aggregate 22A Mod. Materials shall be stockpiled and placed as directed by the owner at each respective pit. All measurements of quantities shall be determined by belt scales. The owner shall require scales to be certified. Any other measurement method shall not be used without the written permission of the owner.
6. The following unit prices shall be payment in full for producing and stockpiling the estimated quantity of surfacing aggregate 22A Mod. at the pit indicated. Pulled sand is incidental to the price of 22A Mod.
7. A primary crusher is recommended to be used in the processing of the 22A Mod. gravel.
8. The bidder has inspected the site noted below and understands the location for the excavation and the stockpiling of the surfacing aggregates.
9. The surfacing aggregates are deposited into the stockpile using a conveyor, the contractor will strike off and compact the stockpile in lifts no greater than 4' as the stockpile increases in height.
10. To obtain 22A Mod. gravel, sand may have to be pulled which shall be incidental to the price of 22A Mod. The pulled sand quantity is only an estimate for bidding purposes. The successful bidder shall have equipment to "pull sand" while producing the 22A Mod. Gravel.
11. All topsoil shall be removed and place in a berm at the South East and South West corners of the property. The estimated area is 2.5 Acres by 8 inches of topsoil.

12. It is strongly suggested that all bidders meet with an owners representative at the pit site(s), so that it is mutually understood on the location(s) of the excavation.
